## Jonah 3:1-5, 10 Common English Bible

The LORD's word came to Jonah a second time: <sup>2</sup> "Get up and go to Nineveh, that great city, and declare against it the proclamation that I am commanding you." <sup>3</sup> And Jonah got up and went to Nineveh, according to the LORD's word. (Now Nineveh was indeed an enormous city, a three days' walk across.) <sup>4</sup> Jonah started into the city, walking one day, and he cried out, "Just forty days more and Nineveh will be overthrown!" <sup>5</sup> And the people of Nineveh believed God. They proclaimed a fast and put on mourning clothes, from the greatest of them to the least significant.

<sup>10</sup> God saw what they were doing—that they had ceased their evil behavior. So God stopped planning to destroy them, and he didn't do it.
