## IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENTS

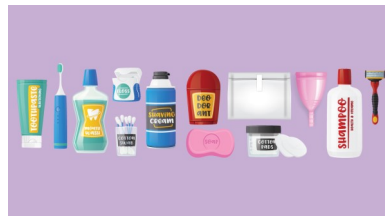
- **Sunrise Service King Park:** Easter Sunrise service is at 7:15A at King Park, with a light breakfast following the service.

My particular need for help now is due to beginning a transition to a new medication for chronic migraines, while phasing out the old plan. I'm not sure what this will look like in the coming weeks, but I'm anticipating some rough patches ahead due to pain. Even with a strong heart of faith, this is somewhat scary as it's exceedingly difficult to be exhausted, in pain, and alone much of the time.

This is a very public, open and earnest plea: I do so need the wisdom, experience, possible practical help of my church family (the Body of Christ), even beyond the few friends I have in Hesston now.

My hope is that someone(s) reading this will have an idea or two that might aid me in this challenging season of my life -- to offer ongoing emotional support/presence, to run an errand now and then, to offer listening ears when I'm hurting but cannot take medication that day, maybe to share coping techniques new to me.....or whatever else may occur to you or to someone you know!!
